Milestones for the circular economy

Designers, architects and trade planners can make a decisive contribution to living in keeping with climate concerns or the transformation in building. "In addition to favouring the use of renewable raw materials, it is particularly important to establish a genuine circular economy", Jonathan Lunkheimer emphasises. Under the title "Sustainability Matters", the specialist for innovative materials, Dr Sascha Peters, will introduce pioneers of the circular economy. Other sources of inspiration for sustainable design are provided by the interzum Award 2023 with the new category "Neo Ecology", which distinguishes ecologically pioneering products, processes and concepts.

A "turning point" in design?

Thematically, interzum 2023 will move in many additional areas that designers are concerned with today: digitalisation and generative production, reduction of living space, demographic design or green mobility. The requirements for design will change over the long term with such diverse forms of transformation. "These days, design trends no longer change on a seasonal basis, they are driven by longer-term considerations", says trend expert Katrin de Louw. She is designing the programme of the interzum Trend Stage, on which material researchers will speak, as well as colour experts and start-ups for self-shaping furniture or organically based plastics. The transformation of living will also provide the theme for the Trend Forum Function & Components: with "Furniture in Change - Shifting Boundaries", byform productdesign will present a new furniture aesthetic at interzum.

Creative processes start with an idea, which is then followed by the selection of materials and components. The mix of new products, technologies and concepts at interzum provides a variety of impulses for this. Whether minimalist fittings design. Antiviral furniture fronts, smart operating technologies or vegan leather alternatives —it is precisely this wide range that makes not only the latest materials and manufacturing processes evident at the fair, but also the trends and visions for future design. With future themes relevant to design and close to the market, interzum thus remains a platform for professional exchange and an extraordinary source of inspiration.
