networking and inspiration, but will also improve visitor navigation thanks to optimised, topic-orientated routes. Furthermore, making use of the fourth entrance on the western side as well as the additional halls (4.2, 5.1, 5.2) and opening up the entire trade fair boulevard will speed up connections between the hotspots across the exhibition areas and event spaces. Another highlight is the Work Culture Festival, organised by members of the German Interior Business Association (IBA e. V.), which is destined to become a cornerstone of the trade fair in Halls 6 and 9.
