COLOGNE FINE ART & DESIGN 2021 with a fine selection of dealers and galleries presenting exquisite works form art and design from early times to the modern era

Special events: "Vienna 1900" and "Sculptures of the Teke"

"Showroom" reconfigured and curated by Sebastian Jacobi

The 51st COLOGNE FINE ART & DESIGN presents itself from 17 to 21 November 2021 in Cologne with a fine selection of dealers and galleries. The journey through time of around 60 galleries and dealers at COLOGNE FINE ART & DESIGN ranges from early specimens from Antiquity through furniture design between classic and modern to art and objects from Europe and non-European regions. Two special exhibitions offer insights into special collection areas and periods of art. The traditional art and design fair this year takes place parallel with ART COLOGNE, which presents around 150 select galleries. Together with the leading German art fair for prewar, modern and contemporary art, COLOGNE FINE ART & DESIGN offers an in every respect worthwhile art experience.

Daniel Hug, Director of COLOGNE FINE ART & DESIGN and ART COLOGNE, is looking forward to seeing both art fairs coincide at the same time, which perfectly supplement one another: "There are no limitations to Cologne Fine Art & Design, which encompasses all epochs, all styles, from early times to the modern era. Both informing and complimenting the fine art of the 20th and 21st centuries presented at ART COLOGNE."

Old Masters and arts and crafts are represented at this year's COLOGNE FINE ART & DESIGN by dealers such as Kunsthandel Dr. Thomas Schmitz-Avila (D), Kollenburg Antiquairs (NL), meinweiss Home S. Jacobi (D), Elmar Robert Medieval Art (D), Don Verboven (BE), Floris van Wanroji Fine Art and Viebahn Fine Arts (D). Niko van Keep (NL) also has a focus on antique timepieces and Brenske Gallery (D) on Russian icons. Dr. Tilman Roatzsch (D) and Galerie Balbach (D) once again exhibit Biedermeier furniture from the 18th and 19th centuries. Presenting some of the earliest artifacts at the fair, new exhibitor Jean-David Cahn (CH), is presenting a selection of rare antiquities, and in a second shared booth with Galerie Dierking (CH) antiquities in dialog with the contemporary artist Otto Boll (*1952) .

The era of Art Nouveau and Secessionism is found with the exhibitors Kunsthandel Wolfgang Gützlaf (D), as well as with the Galerie bei der Albertina (A) and Galerie W&K Wienerroither & Kohlbacher (A), both of which are cooperating on the special exhibition "Vienna 1900". Entirely in keeping with this is the offering from The Lamp Gallery (D), with lamps from the Victorian and Edwardian eras.

Since 2019 Design has been playing a more pivotal role at COLOGNE FINE ART & DESIGN, 20th century design dealers such as Martin Bohn + Partner Galerie formformsuche (D), Guelfucci (D) and Zitzo Modern design (NL) enhance the offering with design highlights. Gisbert Pöppler (D) convinces with design objects of the 21st century, where as Vivid (NL), is presenting fine artists together with vintage and contemporary designers blurring the boundaries. Kaune (D) presents contemporary photographers mixed with vintage mid-century modern furniture ranging from Eames

Hans Martin Schmitz (D) presents exceptional and rare Japanese Netsuke, tribal arts of African can be found at Martin Doustar (GB), Dierking (CH) and Simonis (D), the latter which will also present an important collection of Teke sculptures in a special exhibition. André Kirbach (D) masterfully contrasts Asian art, antiques and modern art, just as the Brussels-based dealer Herwig Simons (BE) dissolves the boundaries between directions of art and eras.

Galerie Francaise (D), Gilden's Art (UK) and Kunsthandlung Osper (D), as well as Michael Schwaze Fine Art (A) present modern and postwar prints and art.

Contemporary galleries are also present, Sakhile&Me (D), THK Gallery (SA) with contemporary African artists, as well as CHOI&LAGER Gallery (D) exhibiting a mix of Korean and European artists. Rosemarie Jäger (D) will show works by artists who move between jewellery making, arts and crafts and fine arts in their work. In the process, Galerie Andreas Binder (D) and Galerie Martina Kaiser (D) build a bridge to ART COLOGNE, which is taking place parallel, with established contemporary positions.

The special exhibitions for COLOGNE FINE ART & DESIGN

With the special exhibition "Vienna 1900", visitors are provided insights into the period of the fin de siècle Secession in Vienna, when visual artists like Gustav Klimt, Egon Schiele and Oskar Kokoschka and designers such as Josef Hoffmann processed a new understanding of the human body and the psyche in their craft, thus making pioneering contributions. The Vienna-based galleries W&K Kunsthandlung Wienerroither & Kohlbacher and Galerie bei der Albertina Zetter will collaborate in presenting Vienna 1900.

„Teke“ presents ritual figures from the Teke people from the Republic of Congo, the Democratic Republic of Congo (formerly Zaire) and Gabon. Long appreciated by collectors worldwide as works of art in all their diversity, the craft of the Teke today highlights an important contribution to the wealth of the cultures of Africa. The special exhibition, with its more than 40 pieces, is organised by Galerie Simonis in Düsseldorf, which specialises in the art of Africa.

"The Showroom" will present a new exhibition concept. Chosen and curated by the design and furniture expert Sebastian Jacobi, art and applied art come together in rooms emulating a domestic setting. The Showroom will stimulate viewers to positively charge their own private living space through objects of art, design and applied arts, but also through light, shadows, colour and balanced proportions. Like

in the familiar "Young Collectors Room", all objects and art on view will be available at prices below 5,000 Euro.

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COLOGNE FINE ART & DESIGN will take place in hall 3.2. which is directly connected with ART COLOGNE via the passageway from the Entrance Hall South at Koelnmesse. The preview for invited guests takes place on 17 November 2021, the vernissage day is on 18 November 2021, and the fair is open to the public from 19 to 21 November 2021.

The package of measures of Koelnmesse will be deployed to guarantee the safety of fair participants: access with digital tickets and "3G" (vaccinated, recovered, tested). Within the fair grounds, the visit will be safely regulated with hygiene and safety measures coordinated with authorities.
