ART COLOGNE PALMA MALLORCA unveils the Participating Galleries in its 2026 Edition

January 15, 2026 - ART COLOGNE PALMA MALLORCA announces the participation of 88 galleries and non-profit institutions from 20 countries, presented within two defined exhibition concepts, GRAN SALÓ and PARKOUR. The fair will take place from 9 to 12 April 2026 at the Palau de Congressos de Palma, reaffirming the island of Mallorca's position as a growing international platform for contemporary art.

An International Selection with a Strong Mediterranean Core

The long anticipated 2026 edition brings together a total of 88 galleries, among them 32 Spanish galleries, nearly half of them based in Mallorca, alongside 26 galleries from Germany and a broad international contingent from across Europe and beyond, including Denmark, Norway, Sweden, the United Kingdom, the United States, Eastern Europe, Korea, South Africa, and South America.

This geographic breadth positions Palma as a meeting point between established European art centers and emerging international scenes. It also highlights the fair's focus on discovery, exchange, and context rather than scale, with an international selection, a strong local presence, and a clearly defined exhibition structure.

A Distinct Local Ecosystem

ART COLOGNE PALMA MALLORCA, conceived as a focused, high-end fair centered on curatorial clarity, dialogue, and long-term engagement with galleries, collectors, and institutions, is presented in partnership with Art Palma Contemporani, the island's gallery association.

As such, 14 Mallorcan galleries are represented in the 2026 edition, reflecting the island's increasingly visible gallery landscape. Participants include established spaces such as Baró, Kewenig, Pelaires, and Xavier Fiol, alongside newer galleries including Florit/Florit, La Bibi + Reus, and Galeria Fermay.

Mallorca's institutional presence further reinforces this context. During the fair, Es Baluard Museu d'Art Contemporani will present a major exhibition dedicated to Jannis Kounellis, alongside ongoing programs at the Fundació Pilar i Joan Miró a Mallorca, del Casal Sollerich and CCA Andratx.

Two Exhibition Concepts: GRAN SALÓ and PARKOUR

The 2026 edition introduces a clearly articulated format structured around two sections.

GRAN SALÓ presents galleries within a classic art fair layout, offering a clear
