ART COLOGNE PALMA MALLORCA invites galleries to apply

Cologne/Palma, 24 September 2026. Following its successful premiere in April 2026, ART COLOGNE PALMA MALLORCA is going to the next round: from 1 to 4 April 2027, it once again brings modern and contemporary art at the highest level to the Balearic Islands. In step with the procedure for ART COLOGNE, galleries can apply for participation as of now until 14 October. An international advisory committee decides on the assignment of the stand placements.

With the second edition of ART COLOGNE PALMA MALLORCA, the successful cooperation with Art Palma Contemporani, the association of contemporary galleries on Mallorca, will be continued. The picturesque Palau de Congressos de Palma, located at the seaside, will for four days offer international galleries, collectors and art enthusiasts a temporary home at the heart of Mallorca. ART COLOGNE PALMA MALLORCA will be accompanied by a series of exclusive events at culturally significant and inspiring places on the island.

New MOVING IMAGE ART section

Like in 2026, stand areas will be assigned in the sections GRAN SALO and PARKOUR. New is the section **MOVING IMAGE ART** in the beautiful auditorium theatre. The 4.20 x 7.50 m screen provides the ideal space for the impressive presentation of extraordinary films, videos and digital works by artists. Applications for 20-minute time slots are also possible without an additional stand area. The selection of the galleries for all sectors is at the discretion of the advisory committee consisting of Maria Baro (Baró, Palma/Paris/Abu Dhabi), Xavier Fiol (Xavier Fiol, Madrid/Palma), Alex Flick (Gathering, London/Ibiza), Stefan Lundgren (Lundgren, Palma), Christian Nagel (Nagel Draxler, Berlin/Cologne/Meseberg), Frederic Pinya (Pelaires, Palma) and Fran Reus (Reus, Palma).

Continuation following the successful premiere

With its first edition, ART COLOGNE PALMA MALLORCA 2026 impressively demonstrated its role as a meeting point of the international art scene in the Mediterranean region. From 9 to 12 April 2026, 88 galleries from 20 countries, including 19 from the Balearic Islands, presented a carefully curated selection of artistic positions in the light-flooded Palau de Congressos. The premiere registered more than 10,000 visitors and convinced with a strong international collector presence. In addition to an art-savvy local public, many collectors from Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Scandinavia and the United States of America were represented. The event connects the decades of expertise of ART COLOGNE - the
